## MISSOURI CORN SCHOLARSHIP



2015 College Scholarship Guidelines

The Missouri Corn Growers Association and Missouri Corn Merchandising Council will award a total of seven \$1000 scholarships to college juniors and high school seniors for the 2015-2016 school year. Guidelines for interested applicants are as follows:

- 1. Applicant must be a full-time college junior, having completed at least 60, but fewer than 90 semester credit hours, currently attending a four-year Missouri college or university with area of study in the field of agronomy or related field. Scholarship funds will apply towards the senior year of expenses for each winner.
- 2. Applicant must be a Missouri resident from a Missouri farm or rural area.
- 3. Applications must be returned via U.S. Postal Service, Federal Express or UPS to the Missouri Corn office **by February 6, 2015**. Applications postmarked later than February 6, 2015, received later than February 13, 2015, or submitted via email or facsimile will not be accepted for consideration.
- 5. Application must include an official college transcript for proof of grade point average and enrollment.
- 6. Application must include at least one letter of recommendation from someone other than a relative.
- 7. Applications will be reviewed by the Missouri Corn Scholarship Committee in March 2015. Scholarship recipients will be notified by mail on or before April 15, 2015.
- 8. Recipient must:
  - Provide Missouri Corn with a proof of enrollment and participation in the study of agronomy or related field from a Missouri college or university dated after September 1, 2015 and received no later than September 30, 2015 or risk forfeit of scholarship.
  - Assist at one of the following Missouri Corn events: golf tournaments, clay shoots, fairs, conferences or other events approved by Missouri Corn.
  - Once requirements are met, the scholarship will be sent directly to the recipient on or before October 15, 2015. In the event any portion of the funding is not used by the recipient, the unused portion shall be returned to Missouri Corn.
- 9. Immediate relatives of any Missouri Corn Growers Association/Missouri Corn Merchandising Council board or staff member are ineligible to receive a scholarship.
