


## MISSOURI CORN SCHOLARSHIP 2020 High School Scholarship Guidelines

The Missouri Corn Growers Association and Missouri Corn Merchandising Council will award a total of seven \$1000 scholarships to college juniors and high school seniors for the 2020-21 school year. Guidelines for interested applicants are as follows:

- 1. Applicant must be a high school senior and must have been a full-time student the previous year.
- 2. Applicant must be a Missouri resident from a Missouri farm or rural area.
- 3. Applicant must plan to attend a two-year or four-year Missouri college or university with area of study in the field of agronomy or related field.
- 4. Applications must be returned via U.S. Postal Service, Federal Express or UPS to the Missouri Corn office by Feb. 14, 2020. Applications postmarked later than Feb. 14, 2020, received later than Feb. 21, 2020 or submitted via email or facsimile will not be accepted for consideration.
- 5. Application must include an official high school transcript for proof of grade point average and enrollment.
- 6. Application must include at least one letter of recommendation from someone other than a relative.
- 7. Applications will be reviewed by the Missouri Corn Scholarship Committee. Scholarship recipients will be notified by mail on or before April 15, 2020.
- 8. Recipient must:
  - Provide Missouri Corn with a proof of enrollment and participation in the study of agronomy or related field from a Missouri college or university dated after Sept. 1, 2020 and received no later than Sept. 30, 2020 or risk forfeit of scholarship.
  - Assist at one of the following Missouri Corn events: golf tournaments, clay shoots, fairs, conferences or other approved event.
  - Once requirements are met, the scholarship will be sent directly to the recipient on or before Oct. 15, 2020. In the event any portion of the funding is not used by the recipient, the unused portion shall be returned to Missouri Corn.
- 9. Immediate relatives of any Missouri Corn Growers Association/Missouri Corn Merchandising Council board or staff member are ineligible to receive a scholarship.
